

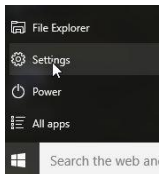
Windows 10

Change the default Email App

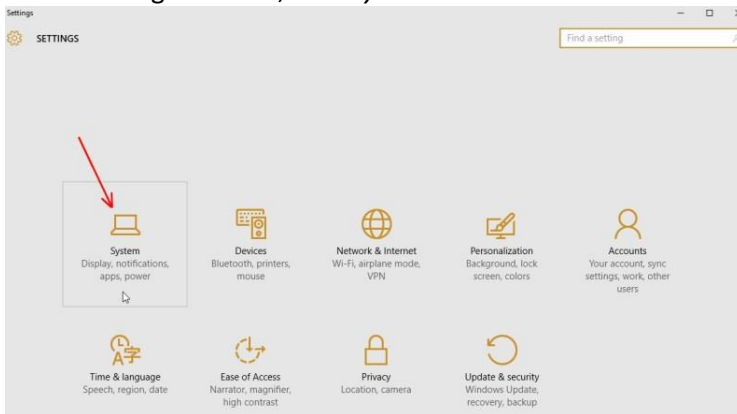
Some people get their email using a web browser – in that case you don't need to read on.

Windows 10 comes with its own built in Email app called *Mail*. Try this out and see if you like it. You may prefer to use a different email client - you can use your choice of *Windows Live Mail*, *Thunderbird*, *Incredimail*, etc. and use it as you did in previous versions of Windows. If you used one of these apps in Windows 7 or 8 and you upgraded to 10 then the app will still be there but you may have to make it the default. For a new Windows 10 computer you need to download and install it, then make it the default.

To make another email client the Windows default: Click on Start > Settings



In the Settings window, click *System*



Click *Default Apps*, look for *Email* and click on the app underneath that (eg *Mail*) and choose your email client (eg *Thunderbird*) which should appear in the drop-down box.
