

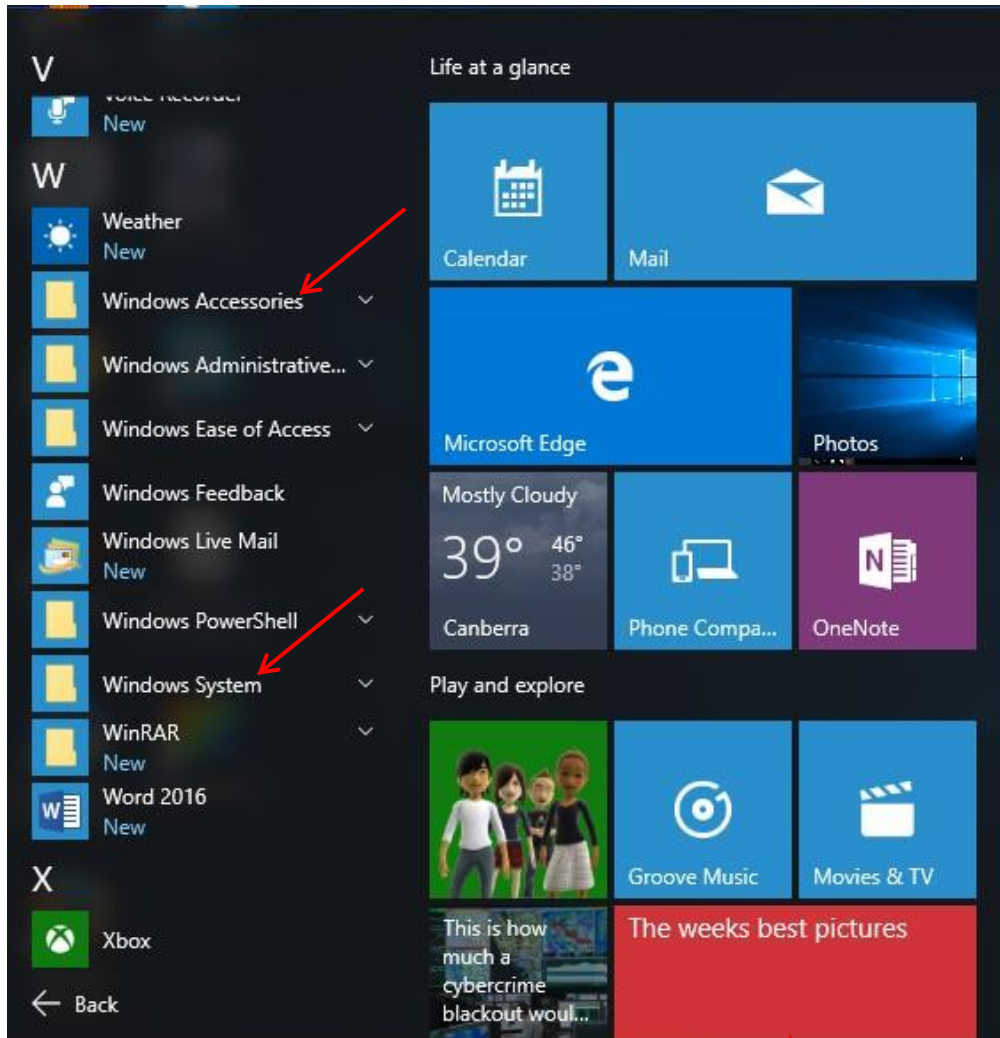

Tips on using the Apps list in the Start Menu

The Apps list is a list of all applications, programs, etc. that are installed on your computer. They are not all listed alphabetically. Many are tucked away in folders in this list.

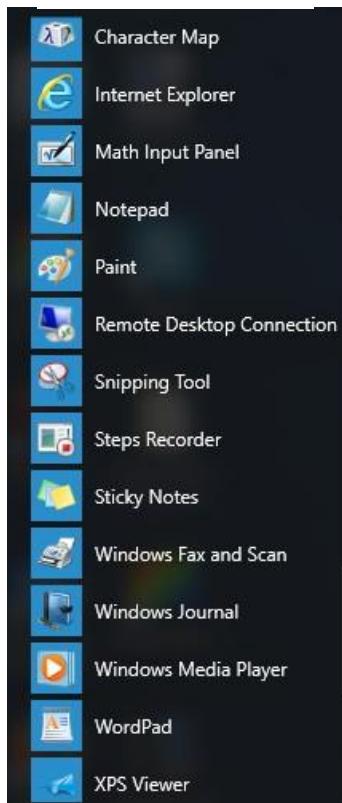
Click Start then scroll down to *Windows Accessories*, open the folder and you will see *Internet Explorer*, *Notepad*, *Snipping tool*, *Steps recorder*, and many other useful tools.

Many of the Windows apps that you might want to use are listed in folders called *Windows Accessories*, and *Windows System*.

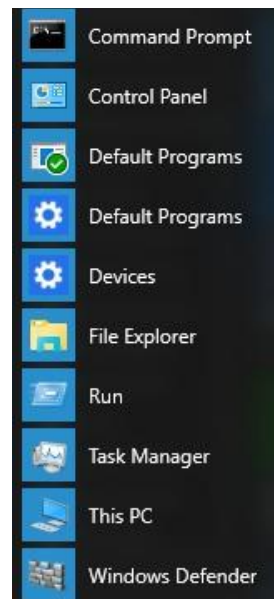


Open these folders to see all the following apps:

For people used to Windows 7, *This PC* is like *Computer*. If you want it more accessible, right click on it and choose *Pin to Start*, or *Pin to Task bar*.

Snipping tool is useful for capturing areas of the screen.

Steps recorder is a new app where you can record a short video of actions you take on your computer
