What is a browser

These are the apps (Software) that allow you to search, find and view or interact with a website. Eg Firefox, Opera, Edge or Internet Explorer

They all do much the same thing. Connect to an Internet address, display the results, manage the scaling of your website view so that it looks okay on your particular device. Tablet, phone or desk/lap top.

Edge is the default browser in Windows 10

We will look at:

1. Tabs and windows
 - a. Click the **More button**, then select **New window**. You can also press **Ctrl+N** on your keyboard.
 - b. Click the **New tab** button next to the current open tab. You can also press **Ctrl+T**
 - c. Drag and drop to reorder tabs
 - d. Preview Tabs **^** toggle
2. Bookmarks or Favorites
3. Home page(s) / Start Pages
4. Search engines (Google, Bing, DuckDuckGo etc)
5. History
6. Navigating – Searching in address bar or going to a website
 - a. Back, Forward and refresh icons
 - b. Home and End keys
7. Add-ons/extensions
8. Protections/settings
9. Viewing
 - a. Zoom/reduce, normal (**CTRL+0**)
 - b. Using two Windows side by side
10. Finding downloads **CTRL+J**
