



Searching for help

Try using phrases like “tips and tricks”; “beginners 101”; “reviews of”; and, “online free” with your search terms.

Let’s all search for “computer courses for beginners online free”

Use your Google search filters to look for videos, and to search for current courses by looking at results for the past year.

Let’s look at our results and explore them

Right clicking is useful here as it lets you open the page in a new tab and keep your search results in their tab.

Google “Everything you want to know about SMARTPHONES but were afraid to ask” OR “Everything you want to know about getting started with a laptop”. Again it is best to set a timeframe to get recent results.

How to use your device

Google “Tips and Tricks for (device) eg. iPad + model number” or (Samsung + model number).
