

The Photostick

This device is a 32GB USB 2.0 stick that contains photo backup software.

The application on USB disk may not run automatically, in which case open the disk in File explorer and manually run *ThePhotoStickWindows.exe* (or *ThePhotoStickMac* on an Apple Mac).

Note that the application does not install - it just runs.

Before clicking the Go button in Photostick

1. If you have your Pictures folder other than in the default location (*c:\users\<username>Pictures*), you need to change the program settings to include the folders required.
2. It only copies .jpg files by default. If you want other picture file types copied you have to tick the appropriate boxes in *Settings > Photo file types*. If you want video files also included, add the folders where they are located (see 1.) then tick the appropriate boxes in *Settings > Photo file types*
3. By default, all photos are paced on the Photostick in a single folder. If you want to keep the same folder structure, Change *Settings > Options > Show advanced copy options >* to "Maintain source directory structure"
4. All pics with size under 100KB were not copied by default, to fix this change *Settings > Options - "Exclude photos smaller than"* to OKB.

Go

Then click "Go", it will scan your selected folders and copy all your files to the Photostick in a folder called *My_Files\<computer name>\My_Photos\Users\<username>\Pictures*

When it has completed copying, check that all your files were copied, close the application then safely remove the Photostick.

Periodically insert the photostick and run the program. It will only copy newly added photos to the Photostick.
